## ELDER'S CORNER

### FATHER'S DAY

**Father's Day is being celebrated** this month and it gives me the opportunity to think back to what a wonderful Christian example my father was for me. My dad was a pastor and loved the Lord and His Word, always expressing his awe at the power of God as Creator of all and God's amazing love as shown in Christ. Looking back, I realize that my father did as God commands in Deuteronomy 6:5-7: *"You shall love the Lord your God with all your soul and with all your might. And these words that I command you today shall be on your heart. You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit down in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise."* My dad died when I was 16 years old which left a father- sized hole in my life, so it was a blessing to me to see the examples of many of the men in my congregation who served the Lord, loved their families, and looked after me and others in that church. I still remember clearly all their faces these many years later and how important it was for them to be strong spiritual leaders as well as devout husbands and fathers. In his book, Real Men Pray, Thomas Couser makes the following statement:

*"As real men pray, we need to ask God to make us into men of faith who provide children and youth with "the love that passes all human understanding." That is something the world can never provide. To be a man of faith requires that we become men of integrity with a strong sense of values. It also requires time to build relationships. I don't care what role you play as a male, you have a responsibility. If you are a dad, your primary responsibility lies within your own home. If God hasn't provided you with some kids of your own, find a young person to mentor. Teach Sunday school, be a youth counselor, volunteer for the scouts or just hang out in the church narthex getting to know the children and youth of your congregation."*

My father and those men of my church were typical men making their mistakes, but "real men" being transparent disciples of Christ. I am sure that when they prayed for forgiveness, they also prayed for strength and the wisdom to pass on the heritage of faith.

On Father's Day I will give thanks for my father and other spiritual fathers who now live in the presence of our heavenly Father who has brought them home and promises the same for us! ✨
